She serves as an advisor for the Ethical Metalsmith Student Committee. Kennedy has most recently exhibited her work at Invitational and Juried exhibits at the Taubman Museum of Art, Roanoke, VA, the Tacoma Art Museum, WA, and Quirk Gallery, Richmond, VA. She has also been awarded the 2017 Haystack Open Studio Residency.
